According to the CC&Rs, Trailers, RVs, boats, campers, motorhomes, ATVs, 5th wheel travel vehicles & haulers are not allowed to be 'stored' in front of your property; that means on the street or on the driveway. The City of Meridian allows some types of vehicles to be hooked up and in front of the home for 72 hours, but then they need to be moved behind your backyard fence or stored in another location.

NEW CITY CODE

The US Postal Service has a policy that it will not deliver mail to a mailbox if there is a vehicle within 10' of the mailbox.

Now the City of Meridian can go ahead and issue tickets to any vehicles that are parked too close to your mailbox. (Similar to Fire hydrants.) This also applies to lawn and landscaping vehicles that are parked near the mailbox for just a short while.

CITY CODE ENFORCEMENT

The City of Meridian would like to encourage online submissions. You can do this by going to <https://meridiancity.org/police/code-enforcement-form>

By using the Code Enforcement Online Complaint Form, you can inform the city about trailers parked on the street longer than 72 hours, homes with excess garbage, tall weeds, cars that are unregistered or nonoperational, cars parked in the wrong direction, extra large trucks, & other code violation issues.

Reports Can be made anonymously.

IRRIGATION WATER

There was a leak behind the pump house and only one backyard line break in 2020. We had a very lucky year. Water should be available some time after the week of April 19th.

If you notice a lot of water accumulating in your back yard please call 1-208-703-4370.

Our HOA Website is updated whenever there is a long period of time that the water will be shut off due to irrigation repairs.

When too many homes try to access the water at one time, the volume of water in the well may get too low and the pump shuts off for a period of time until it can refill with water.
